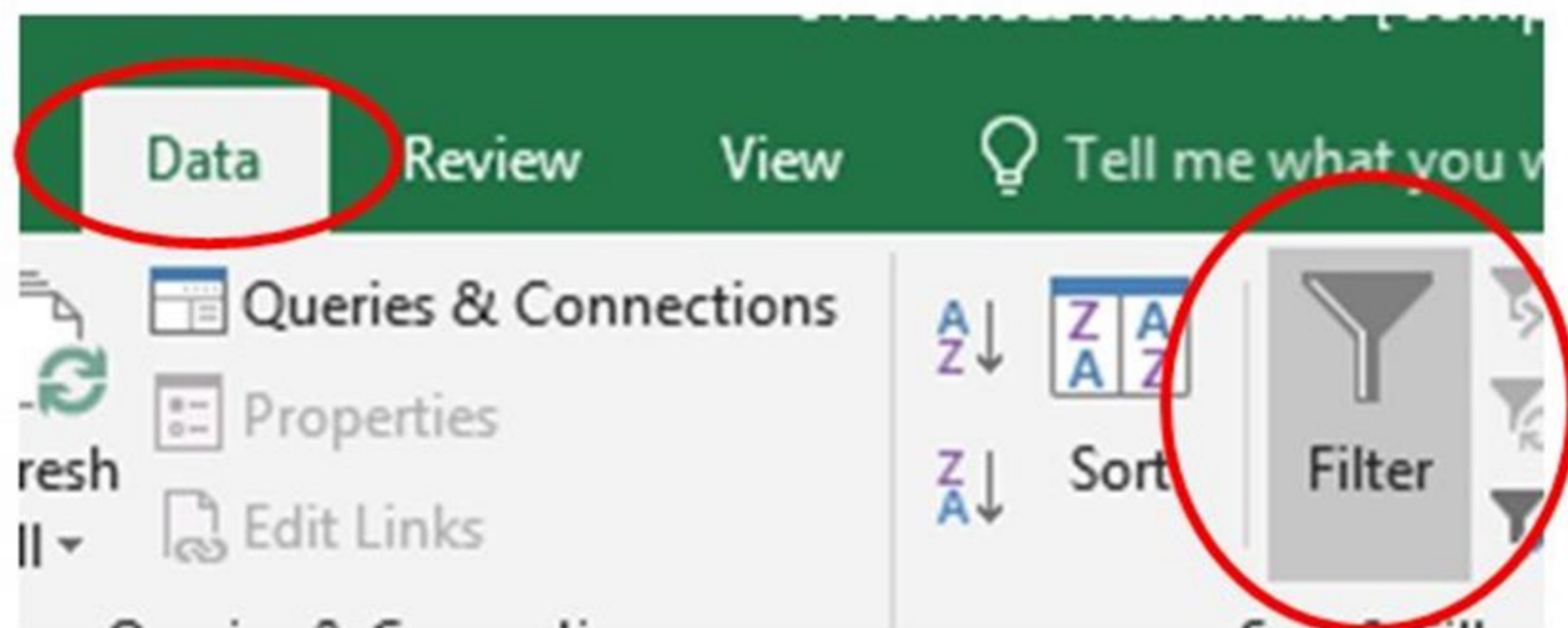

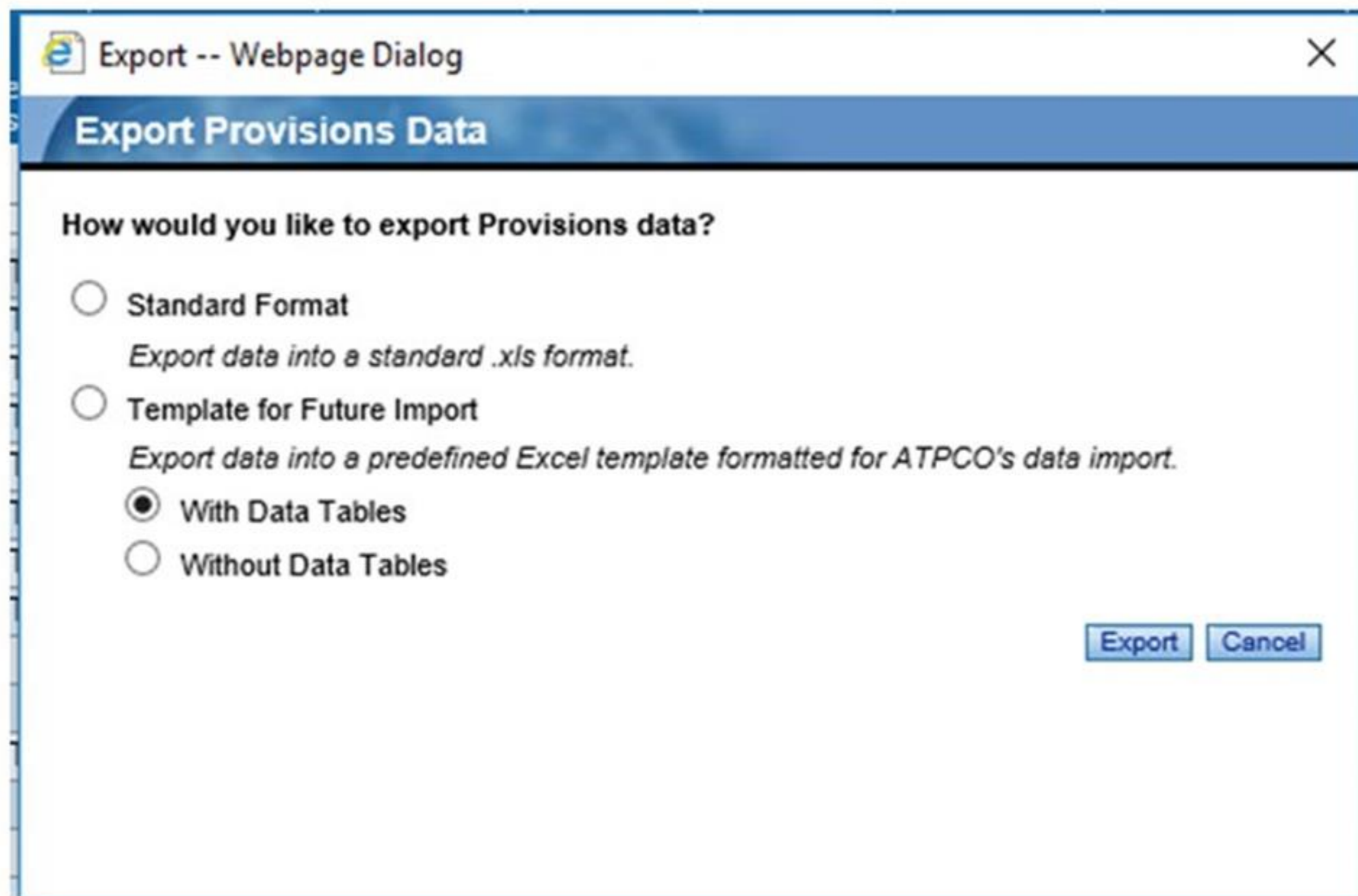

Updates/Clarifications

- Prepaid/Check-in Indicator
 - Moved from Byte 22 to Byte 124. No other changes
 - Positive responses to Milestone 4, no impact to 31 March 2019 implementation
- Data Application Effective 31 March 2019 – Must process Types F and P as well as C
 - Data Migration is not 'big bang' approach. As stated last meeting, systems need time to migrate all hosted airlines
 - 300 Airlines will be migrating their baggage data
- Test File Availability
 - Targeting end of January for Gold Release
 - Test Text File is available for record structure, will be available at BMC site
- Data Application Clarification for OS/OW
 - Milestone 4 and pending data application not defined with the new OW/OS generic sub-codes presented at the Optional Services & Branded Fares working group in September

Data Application Clarification for OS/OW

S7 Baggage in Optional Services Data Application – Section 4.1.37 – Text Table 196 (bytes 368-375) Heavy/Oversize Bags within the Allowance.

Currently reads: When the Free Pieces Number (bytes 269-270) is not exceeded and the sub code is not found (i.e. the weight and/or size of the input bag is greater than the value of all sub codes in the formatted text with Group = BG and Sub Group = Blank), standard sub code 08J* (Note: generic sub codes for heavy and oversize and heavy and oversize within the allowance to be determined) and no excess occurrence is assigned.

Now that generic sub codes defined, update to be: When the Free Pieces Number (bytes 269-270) is not exceeded and

1. Only the weight of the input bag exceeds the weight / unit for the heaviest* standard bag sub code (Group = BG and Sub Group = Blank) specified in the formatted text (as determined by looking up the S5 for the weight per piece), processing shall assign generic sub code 08H (HEAVY WITHIN THE ALLOWANCE) and no excess occurrence is assigned
2. Only the size of the input bag exceeds the size / unit for the largest* standard bag sub code (Group = BG and Sub Group = Blank) specified in the formatted text (as determined by looking up the S5 for the weight per piece), processing shall assign generic sub code 08I (OVERSIZE WITHIN THE ALLOWANCE) and no excess occurrence is assigned
3. The weight and size of the input bag exceeds the weight / unit and size / unit for the for the standard bag sub code (Group BG and Sub Group = Blank) specified in the formatted text (as determined by looking up the S5 for the weight and size per piece), processing shall assign generic sub code 08J (HEAVY OVERSIZE WITHIN ALLOW) and no excess occurrence is assigned

Note: If there is no generic bag sub code found, do not assign a heavy and/or oversize within the allowance generic sub code. If there is no weight / unit or size / unit defined in the S5, the assumption is that the input bag is not overweight or oversize.

*It's possible there are multiple heaviest and/or largest standard sub codes, in which case use the weight of the heaviest and/or largest in the formatted text

04 Jan 19	Can you advise of if we can continue to code OW/OS as we do today, instead of using the new sub-codes? Per the current data app we code overweight or oversize in the applicable sub-code without any occurrences. So, in OFM for instance if there is a free allowance the processing still shows the overweight fee of \$100. Will this need to change, or will the processing logic still work?	<p>All OW/OS sub-codes are to be migrated to the new generic sub-codes (08H/08I/08J) to be compliant with the new data application effective 31 March 19. All current overweight and oversized need to be refiled during the data migration into Baggage Service Type C utilizing the new generic sub-codes and new weight table where needed. (New Sub-codes are defined in the Recommended Sub-code list in the baggage community website.)</p> <p>Recommendation for airlines is to work closely with their system providers, targeting systems/PCC to test, when commencing data migration.</p> <p>Effective 31 March in addition to existing Data Application for Types F and P, subscribers are to process Type C until the migration is complete.</p>	
04 Jan 19	Do you foresee any issues if some of the RFISCs we want to migrate from Type F to C-P are not contained in the Recommended sub code list, e.g., 07P, 07Q, 07R, 07S, 07T, 07V?	<p>This initial recommended list was penned over 12 months ago and needs updating with sub codes that may have been added since that time. There are no issues with using the 07* sub codes listed and migrating them from F to C.</p> <p>Also, a side note, it is F and P that is being migrated to C. Not F to P and C.</p>	ATPCO to revise the recommended sub list and update. Target completion is 22 January 19
03 Jan 19	Is the intent of the standard test data to test the layout changes of the Check-in/Prepaid Indicator, the actual processing or both?	The test data is for the purpose to validate the record layout changes, data load and processing of new values. A text file is available prior to a transmitted test file and may be used to validate the layout changes. Contact BaggageCommunity@atpco.net to receive a copy.
