






Provisions

 On 31 March, the Prepaid/Check-in indicator will be blank, meaning that existing Type C provisions apply to prepaid, check-in and disclosure



- Prepaid/Check-in indicator default view: located near the beginning of grid
- Airlines: Review existing Service Type C filings and ensure the Prepaid/Checkin column is set to the correct value for the strategy; adjust as required
- Distribution Channels: Readiness per the <u>subscriber readiness matrix</u> to process prepaid/check-in Indicator in Type C.







- On 31 March, the Weight/Size Table is visible in the Services grid
- Industry Adoption is not until 31 March 2020



- For use with Overweight/Oversize within Allowance Sub Codes also effective 29 March 2020
- Distribution Channels: Readiness per <u>subscriber readiness matrix</u>


- First PC/Last PC values are protected and cannot be changed →→ Feedback

What Service Type (F or C) would the system process on 01JUL19

- Type C for data for ticket date 01MAY19 ?
- Type F for data for ticket date 01MAY19?
- Type C data as of 01JUL19?
- Look Type F and then, if not found, Type C?







Airline Check-List for Migrating Service Type P to Service Type C and Prepaid/Check-in Indicator

- Advise channels you are ready to begin migration from Type F and P to Type C and gauge their readiness
- Familiarize yourself with Prepaid/Check-in field in the Gold Release
 *** Test in the Gold release ***
- After 31 March: Conduct targeted testing in Production (assuming system readiness)
 - Verify results end to end in a test PNR:
 - Verify pricing, check-in and disclosure results are as expected
 - Verify EMD issuance and reporting
- Once satisfied with above result and you and your system providers are ready, start migrating your data on a larger scale
- Refer to the Baggage Data Migration Guide for efficiencies with analysis and filings





Before Migration of Type P to Type C Can Begin

All applicable Sub codes must be in Services Record S5 under Service
Type C before migrating Service Type F/P data to Type C via Optional
Services Upload or manual updates in Optional Services Application

Where Does Type C Differ from Type F?

- Any reference to 'Sector' under the 'Sector/Portion/Journey' field in Service Type F data must be changed to 'Portion or Journey' before uploading the data into Service type C because 'Sector' value is not applicable under service type C
- Consider Mixed Cabin Application (default is "all sectors")

Branded Fares and Migration of Service Types

Review Branded Fares Features table and ensure that Service Types and sub-codes are aligned with any changes in Optional Services

Review your current Strategies

 Review your existing Baggage policy and ensure the coded sequencing hierarchy regarding the 'prepaid and/or check-in/disclosure' data will produce the expected results per your policy





Filing Actions if a Channel is not Ready

- Before airlines start migrating any data, verify that distribution channels are ready by viewing the <u>Subscriber Readiness Matrix</u> in the ATPCO Customer Center.
- If a single distribution channel is not ready to process the Prepaid/Check-in Indicator:
 - ☐ File a Security Table for point of sale defining all distribution channels except for the channel not ready
 - ☐ Verify with the channel other ways to protect existing data
